Lesson 3: We're Going on a Treasure Hunt Letterboxing is a treasure-hunting game that is similar to geocaching Whereas geocachers rely on GPS units and coordinates, letterboxers seek out hidden containers following clues They then record their discovery in their personal journal with the help of a rubber stamp that's part of the letterbox

Treasure Map - Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis

Treasure Map, a story about a group of students who go on a treasure hunt The students then practice mapping by creating a floor plan of their classroom Next, they use this map to hunt for clues in the classroom Finally, they practice their map-reading skills by using a thematic map (population) to answer the clues and solve a puzzle
